Brenda Morris is the Managing Director for Corporate Compliance and Business Oversight at Affiliated Monitors, Inc. (“AMI”) She has successfully worked in senior corporate legal and compliance positions to provide strategic leadership, enhance business integrity, fortify enterprise risk programs. She has provided training that reinforced business growth and increased employee engagement. Ms. Morris is also an accomplished litigator who has secured trial victories in federal and state courts. She is a frequent speaker on topics ranging from regulatory compliance, parallel investigations, and cybersecurity.

Before joining AMI, Ms. Morris worked for 7 years as Deputy General Counsel at Booz Allen Hamilton (“Booz Allen”), a Fortune 500 Company providing professional services to government and commercial clients. Ms. Morris served as a trusted advisor to executives on sensitive government inquiries and civil litigation. She joined Booz Allen to create the company’s first Business Investigations team, situated within the Legal Department, to conduct internal investigations, as well as provide risk mitigation and litigation management. Ms. Morris hired and led a team of attorneys, investigators, and paralegals to investigate potential violations of the False Claims Act, the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act and other federal laws relating to international contractor integrity and inadvertent release of proprietary information, as well as potential violations of Booz Allen’s ethical codes of conduct.

Ms. Morris established the Litigation and Government Inquiries team (“LGI”) at Booz Allen. The LGI provided rapid response to government inquiries and oversaw complex global litigation. Ms. Morris was a critical decision-maker regarding legal strategies and successful resolution of major litigation, as well as matters that impacted national security. She oversaw outside counsel spend and enhanced the firm’s insurance recovery. She led cross-functional business teams to establish the first Insider Risk Management Program to protect internal information, and established protocols to safeguard the firm against potential cyber-attacks.

Ms. Morris draws upon her years of experience as a Senior Executive Service litigator with the U.S. Department of Justice, Criminal Division, Public Integrity Section. The Public Integrity Section is a distinctive unit responsible for the nationwide investigations and prosecution of white-collar public corruption. Ms. Morris honed her courtroom skills in Manhattan during her tenure as an Assistant District Attorney at the New York County District Attorney’s Office where she conducted hundreds of investigations and secured dozens of trial victories.
