Mark Paskowsky joined Affiliated Monitors, Inc. (“AMI”) as a statistical analyst/consultant in 2017 and in 2021 began serving as the Director of Data Analytics. Mark has over 25 years’ experience conducting statistical analysis, survey research and sampling methodology, database programming, and writing statistical methodologies.

Prior to arriving at AMI, Mark worked in the Massachusetts state government for the Department of Public Health and the Center for Health Information and Analysis (CHIA). In these roles, he managed complex public health surveys including the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System, the Massachusetts Health Insurance Survey, and the Massachusetts Employer Survey. With CHIA, Mark analyzed health insurance survey data and published findings. He also conducted quality control for a Master Database Management system to link individuals between health insurance claims and hospital admissions data.

Additionally, Mark served as the Director of Surveillance and Evaluation for the Massachusetts Tobacco Control Program. He conducted program evaluations of community-based programs and analytics around metrics associated with tobacco use. He also analyzed data for a widely circulated research report on the reduction of tobacco use prevalence among Medicaid recipients in Massachusetts.

In Washington, D.C., Mark provided consultation to A.T. Kearney and the Urban Institute, and he served as a research analyst for several research consulting firms, including ICF International and Maximus Corporation. During this time, he evaluated a wide range of government programs including substance abuse programs, public housing subsidies, work assistance programs, and youth mentoring programs.
