Jerry Coyne is Managing Director of State Monitoring Services at Affiliated Monitors, Inc. At Affiliated Monitors, Mr. Coyne oversees monitoring agreements with corporations, healthcare entities and individuals.

He has led monitoring teams in matters primarily involving consumer protection and long term care facilities. Mr. Coyne also serves as lead monitor of acquisition of a not-for-profit hospital network and its subsequent conversion to for-profit status. In addition, he has participated on numerous teams involving government contracting and procurement, particularly with the Department of Defense.

Mr. Coyne has over forty years of experience as an attorney in both the public and private sectors, most of that time in leadership positions. Mr. Coyne joined Affiliated Monitors in January 2019 after retiring from the Rhode Island Attorney General's office, where he served an unprecedented 20 years as the state's Deputy Attorney General, spanning three administrations. In that role, he supervised 235 employees, including nearly 100 attorneys, spread over four divisions, and oversaw the daily operations of the office and its \$31 million budget.

During his tenure with the Rhode Island Attorney General, Mr. Coyne regularly collaborated with leaders in other AG offices and with the National Association of Attorneys General (NAAG) on matters of national significance, including multistate litigation and investigations, and served on numerous committees. He frequently led review teams for NAAG to provide expertise to other attorneys general, and regularly presented on management topics at NAAG meetings. Mr. Coyne also represented NAAG on the American Bar Association's Task Force on Corporate Monitor Standards. Upon his retirement in 2018, he was presented with a "Meritorious Service Award" by NAAG for career achievement and contributions to the attorney general community.

Mr. Coyne served for twenty six years as a member of the Rhode Island Supreme Court's Character and Fitness Committee and was designated by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to serve as the Committee's Vice Chair (2007-2012) and Chair (2012-2025).

Upon graduation from law school, Mr. Coyne served for five years on active duty in the United States Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps. From 1988-1994, he served as a prosecutor in the Criminal Division of the Attorney General's office, focusing on organized crime and environmental crime, and heading the office's grand jury unit. He subsequently worked for six years in private practice, concurrently serving as Legal Counsel to the Majority Leader of the Rhode Island House of Representatives.

Mr. Coyne is a 1983 graduate of Suffolk University Law School and a 1980 graduate of Boston College. He has also completed studies at the Kennedy School of Government and the Naval Justice School.
